

The Hamilton County Family and Children First Council (FCFC) is currently seeking parent representatives to serve on its Executive Committee. Parent representatives provide their input and insight into the service delivery system by representing the perspective of families served by these programs.

Representatives are full voting members of the FCFC and are required to attend up to four meetings a year as part of the Executive Committee. Meetings are held on the first Friday of the month at noon. In 2022, meetings will be held Feb. 4, May 6, Aug. 5 and Nov. 4. Meetings typically last about an hour.

FCFC parent representatives must have a child(ren) receiving services, or who previously received services, from an agency represented on the Hamilton County FCFC or another County's Council. All positions on the FCFC are non-paid, volunteer positions. Parent Representatives cannot be employed by an agency represented on the Council. The organizations or agencies represented on the Council include Hamilton County DD Services, Hamilton County Job and Family Services, Cincinnati Public Schools, Hamilton County Administration, Hamilton County Juvenile Court, Hamilton County Educational Service Center, Hamilton County Mental Health and Recovery Services Board, Hamilton County Health Department and Hamilton County Community Action Agency.

The Hamilton County Family and Children First Council (FCFC) was established by county commissioners as part of Ohio Family and Children First.
